




# Imagine...




## Invisible Hardships

It is hard to imagine that so many of our students are facing financial hardships.


Almost 40% of our students live below the poverty line today. Family poverty impacts our students' ability to learn in so many ways.

Last year, The Angel Foundation for Learning disbursed \$49,670 in general requests, assisting students in 104 schools. Such financial assistance helps students in many ways, including helping to ensure that no student is left behind when classes participate in school excursions such as trips to Ottawa, Quebec City, Camp Olympia and the Toronto Zoo, to name a few.

The Foundation's school allocations also disbursed \$17,600 for Student Nutrition Program requests, supporting students in 16 schools.

City Councillors, Provincial Delegates and the media are all in attendance.













