


#### Our Mission

## **Student Nutrition Programs**

Each day, approximately 30,000 TCDSB students in 109 schools rely on one of 132 Student Nutrition Programs to receive a healthy breakfast, lunch or snack. One in three TCDSB students participate in a morning meal program five days a week. Students who have had a healthy and nutritious morning meal are ready to learn and have improved attention spans.

Municipal and provincial government grants account for a portion of the costs associated with running our Nutrition Programs, while the remaining costs are covered through fundraising initiatives, parent donations and local community sponsorships. Breakfast Clubs of Canada and Breakfast for Learning also provide support for some of our programs.




