The grant was awarded after Annalisa's presentation on child poverty that illustrated all that AFL does to support students and families in need. The Youth and Philanthropy Program provided curriculum support for her grade 10 Civics and Citizenship class. Annalisa says she personally witnessed the work of the Foundation in action in her elementary school, helping many students who needed various types of assistance. The \$2,500 grant will be matched by the Foundation so that Loretto College can enhance access to technology for all students.

Rotary Club Toronto Supports New Student Equity Initiative

Newly launched, the Student Equity Fund for Post-Secondary Education aims to eliminate the financial barrier for students who wish to apply for college or university. Also known as The Peggy Project, this new initiative



was made possible through a grant of \$10,000 from The Rotary Club of Toronto, and through bequests from the estates of former MSSB and TCDSB employees.

The fund provides students in financial need with vouchers to offset the cost of applying to postsecondary institutions. Students may also opt in to potentially connecting with an adult mentor in their field of study in the future. Our thanks to TCDSB Guidance staff for all their support and assistance in launching this new initiative.

Where Your Money Goes

Every donation we receive goes to support students and families across the TCDSB. From September to the end of November, the Foundation distributed approximately 4,340 grocery cards valued at \$50 each (\$217,000) to families across the TCDSB. AFL also provided \$13,350 in vouchers for school apparel thanks to one of our sponsors, McCarthy Uniforms, and with the support of a grant from the Rotary Club of Toronto, vouchers totalling \$4,675 were also distributed to graduating high school students to offset the cost of applying to university and/ or college. This was in addition to the more than \$24,000 distributed through social work emergency funds, extreme needs, arts and camps funds, reliable life and Loretto funds. Wherever help is needed, the AFL is able to respond.
