Merry Christmas! Happy Holidays!

This school year has started off with many financial challenges for students and families who were already hard hit by the pandemic and the resulting restrictions. It has also been a tough start to the year for the Angel Foundation for Learning as we saw unprecedented increase in requests for assistance from the TCDSB community, while at the same time, donations have been slow coming in.



So far this calendar year, AFL has already distributed more than \$80,000 in vouchers for school apparel and we expect the needs to continue to grow as schools welcome additional newcomers from Ukraine and elsewhere in the world devastated by conflict, hunger, poverty and persecution.

We continue to provide emergency assistance under our Guardian Angel Funds, which supports students, families and newcomers with grocery cards, emergency funds for basic and essential needs to the tune of \$87,843.40 since September, while donations have only totalled \$39,632.79 during the same period. Please open up your hearts and wallets. Your help is urgently needed, to add to the donations from our corporate partners and individual donors in order for the Foundation to keep pace with this growing demand. This is especially true at this time of the year when our thoughts are on Advent and Christmas, the season of charity and love. Please keep The Angel Foundation for Learning top of mind when you are planning local fundraising activities, and know that any funds raised go right back into TCDSB schools to help














In addition, all those attending will receive a promotional code for discounted tickets to any remaining game in the regular season, and a portion of those tickets sold will also be donated to AFL.
