





AFL STUDENT BURSARY FOR INDIGENOUS YOUTH

Bursary Description

As part of the ongoing journey towards Truth and Reconciliation and ensuring Every Child Matters, this Student Bursary for Indigenous Youth is administered through the Angel Foundation for Learning and co-sponsored with the TCDSB Indigenous Education Department to help defray the cost of post-secondary education. Two (2) bursaries each of \$5,000 is available to a graduating First Nations, Inuit and Métis student who are registered in the Toronto Catholic District School Board requiring financial assistance to pursue post-secondary studies at a college or university.

Criteria

Selection of the successful candidate will be based on the following criteria:

- self-identify as First Nations, Inuit or Métis
- attend a TCDSB secondary school
- provide or demonstrate academic proficiency
- ouitline contribution(s) to the school or your community
- provide description of financial need and/or personal challenges
- provide letter of acceptance into a post-secondary institution
- and is not a dependent of an AFL employee.

Application Process

Application must be completed with all of the following criteria for consideration of this bursary:

- submit the completed and signed application form provided below
- provide a personal cover letter, outlining contribution(s) to the school or your community
- state the nature of financial need including as much detail as appropriate
- letters of recommendation from any two of the following: the school principal or designate, employer, coach, department head, chaplain, support staff, teacher, community leader, Elder, Knowledge Keeper or an Indigenous organization. The letters should outline contributions to the school or community
- provide letter of acceptance into a post-secondary institution.

Selection Process

The successful candidate will be approved by the Board of Directors of The Angel Foundation for Learning, upon the recommendation of the review committee. This review committee to review candidates will include members of the TCDSB Indigenous Education Department, and the Indigenous Education Council and the Angel Foundation for Learning. The successful candidate will be notified in early June.
